

Dozens from the Security Community Have Determined: The Agreement with Iran is a Fait Accompli

Dozens of security professionals are calling on the government to renew faith in and to strengthen security-diplomatic cooperation with the American government. The call is to initiate a process of increasing Israel's credibility in support of the two state solution and to set the stage for a possible Sunni-West alliance against extremist forces that undermine stability in the region.

Among the signatories: Former Head of the Shin Bet, Ami Ayalon and Carmi Gillon, Former Deputy Head of the Mossad Amiram Levine, Uzi Elam – Retired Brigadier General, Head of the Ministry of Defense and Chief of the Committee for Nuclear Energy in the Prime Minister's Office, former generals David Ben-Besht, Shlomo Gazit, Alex Tal, Aviezer Yaari, Amram Mitzna, Mendi Maron, Danny Rotschild, Giora Ram, Mica Ram, Amnon Reshef and Natan Sharoni, and many other senior officers.

The full text of the petition:

From a view that the agreement with Iran is a fait accompli

We the undersigned turn to the government of Israel to adopt a policy that will:

- Renew faith and strengthen diplomatic and security cooperation with the US government in order to prepare for the varied challenges which will arise from the agreement, first and foremost:
- To form an understanding of the procedures for monitoring and implementation of the agreement, and of the procedures in place in the case of a breach;
- To create intelligence cooperation to monitor Iran's implementation of the agreement and early detection of any violations;
- To prepare for appropriate action – political, economic, military – in case of a breach of the agreement by Iran;
- To coordinate other intelligence efforts monitoring Iran's subversive activities in the region and preparation for acts of restraint and prevention;
- To form a program of special security assistance to Israel in order to ensure its qualitative military edge without neglecting the quantitative aspects of the conventional arms race that is expected to ensue following the agreement;
- To initiate a political process that will lend credibility to the support of Israel and the two-state solution and that could allow – among many other advantages, the establishment of a Sunni-Western Axis alliance against extremist forces that are undermining stability in the region.

This policy will facilitate the integration of Israel's capabilities with those of all other countries in the region and the international community towards a view a nuclear Iran as a grave threat, and to attempt to curb subversion with determination in the region and beyond. It will also mobilize moderate Arab states to promote a political settlement with the Palestinians.
